



34 year old Lewy was born in Edinburgh, Scotland and began his career with Dundee and Edinburgh before earning his first international callup with GB U18s for whom he iced 9 times. Lewy then forged his career in the Elite League with Belfast Giants, and a brief stint in Basingstoke, before joining MKL in 2008. He has remained with the MK hockey family since then, and last weekend saw him play his 600th game in an MK Lightning Jersey (one of only 3 players to do this).

Lewy plays hard all game long, and is well known for his ability to close down opposition forwards, and for playing a critical role on the Penalty Kill where he will often take the first 60 seconds and make it disappear. He's a superb team player, and is relied on by his team mates to make intelligent, consistent plays in his own end and press the team up the ice.


Last season Lewy was made Captain of the team by his team-mates, and led the team on and off the ice.

PLAYER PROFILE



Born in Chelmsford, England on November 9, 2000, Ben Solder stands at 5'10" and weighs 170 lbs. Playing as a defenseman, Solder shoots left. Over the years, he has showcased his skills in various leagues, but his top-scoring season was during the 2022-23 stint with the Bristol Pitbulls in the NIHL. Here, he played 51 games, scoring 7 goals and assisting 22 times, accumulating a total of 29 points with 40 penalty minutes.

Currently, he's lacing up for the Milton Keynes Lightning for the 2023-24 season. With his consistent performance and dedication, Solder is undoubtedly an asset to any team he plays for.

COACH'S COMMENTS

Jake Sylvester is a key player for Raiders IHC, having played 31 games with a notable contribution of 36 points. His scoring prowess is highlighted by 24 goals, complemented by 12 assists. Sylvester's ability to find the back of the net is primarily showcased during even-strength play, with 20 even-strength goals. Despite a relatively low penalty minute count of 4, his scoring impact is significant, particularly in crucial situations.



Aaron Connolly is a vital asset to Raiders IHC, with 32 games under his belt and a total of 27 points. His balanced scoring record includes 12 goals and 15 assists, demonstrating his dual threat as both a scorer and a playmaker. Connolly's contribution is spread across different play situations, with 10 even-strength and 5 power-play points. His 29 penalty minutes reflect his aggressive playing style, which, combined with his scoring capabilities, makes him an intriguing player to watch.

Coy Prevost is a standout defenseman for Raiders IHC, displaying his provess in just 17 games with an impressive 20 points, comprising 4 goals and 16 assists. His offensive contribution is notable, especially for a defenseman, with balanced scoring across even-strength and power-play situations. Prevost's 27 penalty minutes reflect a combination of physicality and aggression in his gameolay.
