Book a behind the scenes Bench with the Lightning experience for you and your friends for an upcoming match.


- 1 Meet your guide outside the Lightning locker room for a quick chat about the tour and ask any questions.

Callum Field was a reliable forward for Milton Keynes Lightning Callum Field was a reliable forward for Milton Keynes Lightning throughout the 2023/24 NIHL season. Over 49 games, Field recorded 8 points (4 goals, 4 assists), contributing valuable depth to the team. Though his scoring was modest, his physical play and defensive responsibilities were crucial to the Lightning's overall team dynamics. In the playoffs, Field continued to work hard, though he was kept off the scoresheet in 6 games. His commitment to the team and ability to perform in key defensive roles make Field a dependable player in the Listerise Lieuren Lightning lineup.

COACH'S COMMENTS

Saturday against Telford we started strong and played with speed and execution. Some things we need to sort out defensively but overall kept our foot on the gas and took over in the third.

Sunday in Bristol was a tight game, good for the fans but I wasn't thrilled with the way that game played out. Bristol played hard and their goalie played very well throughout. We didn't have the urgency until later in the game. Our power play played well this weekend and really helped us get the 4 points. Another big weekend ahead, we need everyone to take their game up a level.

Tanner Butler made a significant impact on the Bristol Pitbulls' blue line in the 2023/24 NIHL season, recording 39 points (9 goals, 30 assists) in 42 games. Known for his physicality and offensive contributions from the back end, Butler provided the Pitbulls with both stability and firepower. His aggressive play style, evident from his 129 penalty minutes, adds a layer of toughness to Bristol's defense.





Bari McKenzie brought his wealth of experience to the Bristol Pitbulls during the 2023/24 NIHL season, where he added 24 points (7 goals, 17 assists) in 32 games. McKenzie, known for his leadership and versatility, quickly became a key figure in the Pitbulls' forward lines. His ability to play both center and right wing, combined with his years of experience across various leagues, makes him a valuable asset as Bristol aims to build on last season's performance in the 2024/25 campaign.

Tommy Nappier, a former standout at Ohio State University, joins the Bristol Pitbulls for the 2024/25 season after a year away from the ice. Known for his strong performances in the NCAA, where he posted a 2.04 GAA and a .932 save percentage in the 2019/20 season, Nappier brings a high level of talent and potential to Bristol's crease. His experience in the AHL and ECHL will be invaluable as he looks to solidify the Pitbulls' goaltending.
