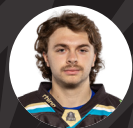

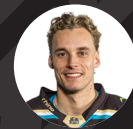
MAN OF THE MATCH

AWAY TEAM'S NOTABLE PLAYERS

Olivier Arseneau made a significant impact in his first season with the Solway Sharks in 2023/24, recording an impressive 55 points (10 goals, 45 assists) in 54 games. His offensive contributions from the blue line, combined with his physical play, make him a cornerstone of the Sharks' defense. Arseneau's ability to drive play and create scoring opportunities will continue to be crucial for Solway in the upcoming season.



Caly Robertson brought his offensive talent to the Solway Sharks in the latter half of the 2023/24 season, recording 30 points (14 goals, 16 assists) in 30 games. Robertson's ability to play on either wing and his knack for finding the back of the net make him a dangerous player in the NIHL. As he gears up for a full season with the Sharks in 2024/25, Robertson is expected to be a key contributor to the team's offensive success.
